

Recommendations for changes for Club By-Laws and expectations from the Policy / Handbook Committee Meeting from August 15, 2006:

- 1) 4-H clubs would be required to have a minimum of 8 meetings per year
- 2) 4-H members would be required to attend a minimum of 4 general meetings per year
- 3) 4-H Project leaders would be required to have a minimum of 4 project meetings per year.
- 4) 4-H members would be required to attend a minimum of 2 project meetings per year
- 5) College students would be excluded for the above requirements, however it would be highly recommended to attend as many as they can of the project meetings and general meetings
- 6) Since 4-H clubs should be doing community service would require each club to submit by July 1st a listing of Community Services listing the number of participants, with number of hours at each event.
- 7) To monitor the club general meetings the Handbook – Policy committee would monitor the Family Focus and if the club minutes are not listed for 2 months would contact the General Leader to follow up.
- 8) For items # 6 and #7 – if by July 1st the community service listing is not received and/or 8 club minutes are not listed in the Family Focus – the club would not be in good standing and the entire club would not be allowed to show at local fairs.
