

# HEALTH AGREEMENT FORM

At all 4-H Horsemasters Events:

For everyone's benefit – Before any horse is allowed off the trailer check for:

- ✓ Fatigue/lethargic behavior.
- ✓ Runny nose or eyes.
- ✓ Enlarged lymph nodes on throat.
- ✓ Coughing/wheezing.
- ✓ Temperature (if health is in question).

At the time of check-in you must turn in & sign in:

- ✓ Original Coggins & copy.
- ✓ Signed copy of Health Agreement (below).
- ✓ Sign Check-in Sheet.
- ✓ If there is any question of illness, the horse will be immediately removed from the grounds.

When checking into clinics/events at the Marathon County Fairgrounds:

- ✓ Do not remove your animal from the trailer until check-in is complete.
- ✓ Be prepared & patient at all event sites for check-in procedures.

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## HEALTH AGREEMENT

To the best of my knowledge, my horse is in good health and is not carrying any diseases or illnesses. I understand that bringing a sick animal to a public event puts other horses at risk.
