Purpose

- Empower and guide youth to train and educate the community to reach outcomes.
- Raise the visibility of the partnership and mission as 4-H Tech Changemakers engage stakeholders. Teen leaders will be trained as spokespeople to lift up and expand youth voice in this critical conversation.
- Infuse positive youth development approaches in relation to citizenship and technology skills development throughout the life cycle of the project. Teen leaders will engage locals to solve their digital literacy issues.

Time required

- Varies; estimated at 6 hours per month for 16 months (March 2019-July 2020)

Responsibilities

- Complete initial and regular trainings in leadership, public speaking, marketing, and technology
- Identify community needs through surveys, research, and stakeholder interviews
- Work with youth and adults to plan out teaching sessions
- Oversee teaching sessions with members in the community around Marathon County
