

# 2019 MASS Education Points Opportunities

## Market Animal Show & Sale of Marathon County, Inc.



To promote raising quality animals within current market standards, continued education for participants is essential. Therefore, each participant must submit a minimum of 10 education points by July 1 in order to be eligible for the Market Animal Show and Sale. Each participant (not the project leaders/advisors) is responsible for completing the required paper work and mailing it to the designated person in one mailing.

### **POSSIBLE POINTS FOR M.A.S.S. EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS**

Please refer to the list below for current educational point opportunities. Remember, in addition to the mandatory January meeting, all participants need to attend at least one MASS sanctioned event (denoted by a \*). *Other comparable events can be used if approved by M.A.S.S. Education Committee prior to the event.*

#### **5 Point Events**

- WLBA show camp in West Allis in June (Beef, Sheep & Swine)
- UW Livestock Judging Camp (full day)
- 4 Workouts & State Meats Evaluation Contest
- 4 Workouts & Area Days Contest in Livestock Judging
- 4 Workouts and Livestock Quizbowl Competition
- 4 Workouts and Skillathon State Competition
- Exhibit Beef, Sheep or Swine at Livestock Shows (including Badger Kickoff, WI State Fair, Athens Fair, World Beef Expo, State or National Breed Association show, WLBA sponsored shows, or others approved by Education Committee Chair)
- Completion of University level course related to Livestock Production
- Member of College Livestock or Meats Evaluation team and participant at regional or national contest

#### **3 Point Events**

- Participation at area animal science days
- FFA State or National convention (1 per year)
- Livestock or Meat Judging at State FFA Career Development Event
- M.A.S.S. Agriculture Career Night\*
- M.A.S.S. sponsored Skill-a-thon contest\*

#### **2 Point Events**

- M.A.S.S. sanctioned events, including Carcass Contest, M.A.S.S. sponsored species meeting, and/or M.A.S.S. sponsored fitting and showing clinics\*
- Member of and participation (attend 4 meetings) as youth member of M.A.S.S. committee
- WCLA Education event and sale (attend both education event and sale)
- Participation in Premier Exhibitor Contest at WI State Fair (must complete quiz, skill-a-thon, livestock judging and showmanship)

- Market Animal clinics sponsored by feed companies (including Marathon Feed, Heartland Co-Op, Central Wisconsin Cooperative)

#### **1 Point Events**

- **LIVESTOCK JUDGING AT WI VALLEY FAIR – PARTICIPANT MUST JUDGE ALL 3 SPECIES FOR 1 POINT TOTAL**
- Master Stockman — 1 point total for completing form and interview
- Attendance at 2 Livestock Judging or Meats Evaluation workouts (max of 2 points for each)
- Participation in both livestock quiz and judging contest at WLBA Summer Spectacular (must attach quiz and judging)
- 1-Page report of a M.A.S.S. event (minimum 1 FULL page)
- Attendance & written report (minimum 1 FULL page) of Club Project meeting (Limit 3 per year — hog, beef or sheep)
- FFA Food for America (FFA members only — include documentation when submitting points)
- Written Report on livestock topic (maximum 1 per year) — (minimum 1 FULL page)

Each Exhibitor may also submit to the education committee chair a self-determined project, which needs prior approval and must be re-approved by the Education Committee Chair EACH year. The Education Committee will determine the points of a self-determined project, but the maximum is 5 points.
