

Wisconsin Valley Fair Horse Show Hunter Hack Jumping Registration

The Hunter Hack class is judged on jumping, rail work at a walk, trot, canter, and hand gallop (judge's discretion). Entries will be required to jump 2 fences: the maximum height of 18" at the center of the fence. The horse and rider combination should be able to competently and safely jump this fence height.

We will have a warm-up practice available during the lunch break. If the horse and rider are having definite trouble jumping the warm-up fences, they should not enter the class. This recommendation will be made, to the superintendents and the judge, by a qualified adult monitoring the practice session. This is in the interest of safety and the timely manner of running the class.

This class is not for the purpose of entering the class and trying it.

To enter the above class, this form must be completed, and signed by a qualified person knowledgeable in the skill of jumping (judge, instructor, clinician, 4H leader). This individual should be familiar with the ability and training of the horse and rider combination.

This form must be completed, and submitted to superintendents, by Tuesday, at Herdsmanship meeting, 4:00 pm, during the Fair.
