Rules Governing Exhibits

Requests for booths/displays must be sent to the 4-H office with fair entry forms.

Division A

- 4-H booths should promote 4-H to the public. FFA booths should promote FFA.
- Upon application from a 4-H club, FFA and FCCLA Chapter in Marathon County, a booth space in the Youth Building will be allotted to that organization. Make sure you identify you club name on your booth.
- Booth requests will be filled on a first come - first serve basis. Booth numbers are limited.

Division B

Marathon County FFA Chapters and 4-H Clubs have the opportunity to display their skills in horticulture by constructing and presenting horticultural displays at the Wisconsin Valley Fair.

The display must be in place by Tuesday at 6 p.m. The display must be removed after 5 p.m. Sunday.

- Each group will be provided with a 4-foot by 4-foot pallet to place their display

- Booths can be set up Monday from 9 a.m. - 4 p.m. and Tuesday from 10 a.m. - 7 p.m. Judging on Wednesday.
- Arrangement of booth must be done by the organization or a committee of each organization
- All booths should show a reasonable amount of thought and effort and be kept in good condition throughout the duration of the Fair. Premium money may be withheld for unworthy booths.
- 4-H Clubs, FFA and FCCLA chapters may choose their own theme
- All project exhibits in booths are not to be entered in individual Divisions
- The size of each booth in the Youth Building is approximately 7 feet wide, 4 feet deep, with 6 foot high background
- Members of the organization may work or demonstrate in the booth if they care to

- The exhibiting group will provide all materials for the display
- Living and non-living materials may be used in the display
- The display must be cared for by the group during the duration of the fair
- Items may be no taller than 6 feet from the top of the pallet
- Any items that could tip or fall from the pallet must be securely fastened
- The displays will be judged by the Fair Board and premiums will be paid
- Exhibits must be non-electrical
