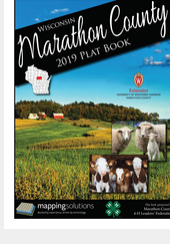


2019 Plat Books are now available at the Extension Marathon County office! Clubs can purchase them for \$35 and then sell them in their communities for \$40.

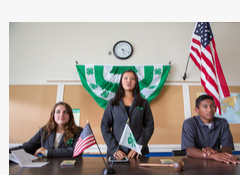

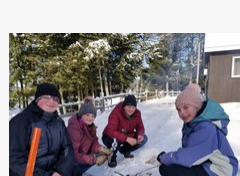
Leaders Federation bi-monthly meeting will be held on Monday, January 27, 2020. All Marathon County 4H members and leaders are invited to attend!

UPHAM WOODS OPPORTUNITIES

The Upham Woods Outdoor Learning Center is the University of Wisconsin Division of Extension nature center, fulfilling the Wisconsin Idea outdoors. It is located two miles north of the Wisconsin Dells, offering educational and recreational programming. The center provides lodging for 200 people, meals, and environmental education year-round.

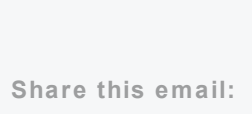


Kaitlyn Bernarde
