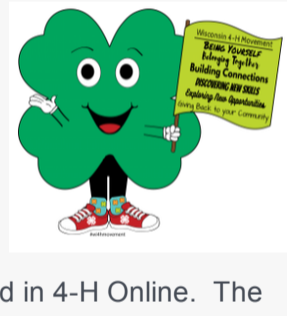
WISCONSIN 4-H FOUNDATION Celebrate the Arts Contest with the 4-H Foundation

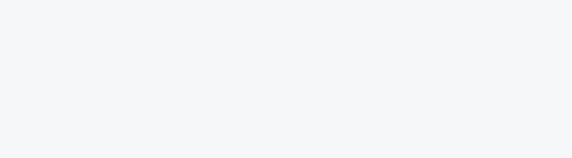
4-H American Spirit (East) Experience

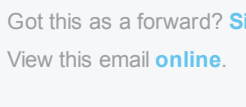
