
Adults who volunteer with young people, care about young people. One way to show we care is to give help and support when someone is feeling down. That's what the Supporting Youth Mental Health for Volunteers Training—Supporting YMH, for short—is all about: knowing how to support youth when they're down, whether it's simply a bad day or it's more than that.

- Supporting YMH has two parts:
1. A 1-hour online training
 2. A 1.5-hour live training—offered virtually or in-person

A team of youth, volunteers, and staff developed this training. Now, it's available to you! MADISON, Wis. – The Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP) will be offering an online training on March 14, 2023 for new and experienced judges to review the principles of being a county and district fair judge.

Topics covered will include the basics and logistics of judging at the county fair including steps to becoming a judge, expectations, and the types of judging, such as conference or face-to-face. At the conclusion of the training, there will also be time for questions.
