Charters and Annual Financial Reports

A 4-H charter indicates the club or group is organized in accordance with the objectives of the 4-H program. It authorizes the club or group to use the 4-H emblem for educational purposes in accordance with laws and regulations established by Congress and the U.S. Department of Agriculture. The purpose of the 4-H Charter is education, communication, and accountability.

4-H clubs and groups must renew their charter annually through completion of the Charter Application Process. Charter Applications are to be completed online by November 1st. The Annual Financial Reports are due September 1.

<u>4-H 2023-2024 Charter Application</u> is now available. A few changes to the charter document include: Added a section for: Club Leader Mailing and email information, Youth President contact information and added additional high risk activities that have policies.

Awards and Recognition




